Expectations and requirements for your section of BIOL 291:

The work plan for **Biology 291** for **Biology 101 Lab** is as follows:

Apprentices help once a week in a scheduled lab for 2 hours and 50 minutes including when exams are administered.

Make sure the lab is set up and all supplies are ready. Materials should be arranged in the lab according to how the exercise runs and the lab rooms should be kept clean.

The apprentice should stay in the lab(s) at all times and not be in the hall or prep room unless getting supplies. The Honor Code is in effect at all times and apprentices should remember that they have access to information that is not to be shared with laboratory students. Apprentices do not grade assignments and cannot teach a lab without a TA present.
